

Academic English Program

(Minimum IELTS 4.5 / Duolingo 65)

The Academic English Program is designed for students with conditional admission to Western University, King's or Huron University Colleges and those pursuing ESL studies. We cultivate student success by developing communicative skills – listening, speaking, reading and writing – in conjunction with the cultural knowledge required to thrive in Western's demanding academic environment.

English Language Proficiency Requirements

Depending on your English language proficiency level when you apply, you will study anywhere from one to three terms, for up to 20 hours per week. Each term is 16 weeks in length.

Our Levels Chart below will help you determine how much time is required for you to successfully complete the program. It details the minimum scores required on various standardized English language tests (IELTS, TOEFL, Duolingo).

If you have not taken any of these tests, we also offer a placement test to determine your English proficiency level.

English Boost Program

(Minimum IELTS 5.5 / Duolingo 100)

The English Boost Program provides 9 weeks of training for students who are just below the English standard for admission to their degree program. The program is designed for students with conditional admission to Western University or one of it's affiliates, and gives them the "boost" they need to meet the standard and succeed in their degree.
